- Potential
- Overall performance and preparation

- We are looking for a versatile colleague who ensures excellent performance on concert stage and whilst mastering on a broad repertoire or working on it.
- You have a professional and flexible work ethic and radiate enthusiasm on every stage.
- As a member of the orchestra, you will also contribute on tour educational projects and social
  activities.
- All employees have a talent for harmonious teamwork and possess good communication skills.
- Foreign colleagues are expected to become a proficiet in the Dutch language or have a good working of English.
- In addition to their musical responsibilities, section principals make an active contribution to the
  management of the orchestra. They lead sectional rehearsals, encourage a collegial working
  relationship with the section and between the other sections and are also the link between
  individual players and management. The principal cellist will occasionally play on the second
  chair. String players have a permanent position.
- For percussion auditions, students may choose to audition on any or all of the following instruments: timpany, snare drum, marimba/xylophone.
- Participants bring their own sticks and mallets to the auditions.
- Be on time on your audition appointment. Each member of the jury has a very large number of auditions to hear, and needs to keep on schedule.
- Warm up thoroughly before the audition. Practice rooms will be available for this purpose during the entire audition period.
- Remember that the goal of these auditions is to involve you in our orchestra, to offer you a growth job and to promote your musical growth.
- There is no reason to be nervious about your audition, we are human beings. Come well e well prepared, confident, and ready to demonstrate your musical stengths to the listeners.
